YOUR RIGHTS

<u>Restrictions</u> – you have the right to request restrictions on uses and disclosures that are permitted by law. The VitreoRetinal Eye Center has no obligations to agree to the restrictions.

<u>Communications</u> – you have the right to request The VitreoRetinal Eye Center to communicate with you be alternate means or alternate places and The VitreoRetinal Eye Center must accommodate such reasonable requests.

<u>Inspection</u> – you have the right to inspect and copy (for a fee) your medical records except for psychotherapy notes, information separately compiled for litigation purposes or separately obtained under a promise of confidentiality, and access that is barred by law. Access may also be denied if The VitreoRetinal Eye Center has reason to believe that access may endanger you or another person. If access is denied for safety reasons, you have the right to have that decision reviewed by an independent health care professional designated by The VitreoRetinal Eye Center for that purpose.

<u>Amendment</u> – you have the right to receive an accounting of all unauthorized disclosures and disclosures required by law including the date of disclosure, the name of the recipient, and a brief description of the disclosure.

Complaints – you have the right to file a complaint without fear of retaliation, if you believe your primary rights have been violated. THE VITREORETINAL EYE CENTER'S DUTIES

The VitreoRetinal Eye Center has the duty to maintain the privacy of your protected health information through reasonable, physical, administrative, and technical safeguards, as well as, through the training and discipline of The VitreoRetinal Eye Center personnel. The VitreoRetinal Eye Center must also make reasonable efforts to mitigate any breach of privacy.

NOTICE OF PRIVACY RIGHT FOR PATIENTS

<u>Health Care Operations</u> – for example, we may use your information in order to support business activities of your physician's practice.

<u>Emergencies</u> – for example, we may use your information in an emergency treatment situation, which will be dictated by your physician.
