TYPES OF FUNDS

- Donor Advised Funds** allow donors to remain actively involved in the grant making process.
- Corporate Advised Funds & Corporate Scholarship Funds** allow corporations and small businesses to remain actively engaged in directing their charitable resources.
- Designated & Agency Funds** benefit a specific nonprofit, Church, or school.
- Employee Emergency Relief Funds** provide financial assistance to employees who experience financial hardships due to an emergency situation.
- Field of Interest Funds** benefit an interest or cause that is important to the donor.
- Scholarship Funds** benefit students pursuing their academic dreams.
- Named Permanent Endowments** allow the CFA Board of Directors, or respective Parish Affiliate Boards, to award grants to organizations.
- Legacy Funds** are established now, but funded via a future bequest or other planned gift.

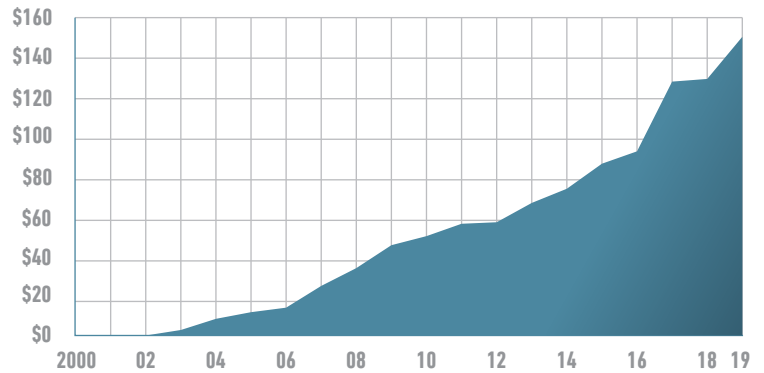
FOUNDATION FINANCIALS

CFA has realized over \$279 million in philanthropic activities since inception in 2000. Currently, CFA has assets of more than \$151 million. CFA's donor-directed grant distributions now exceed \$143 million.

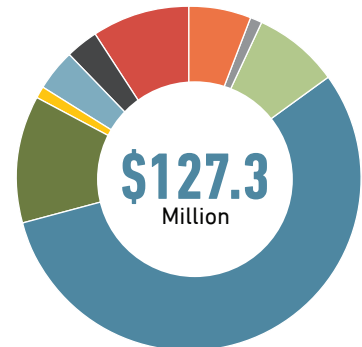

FOUNDATION ASSETS (in Millions)



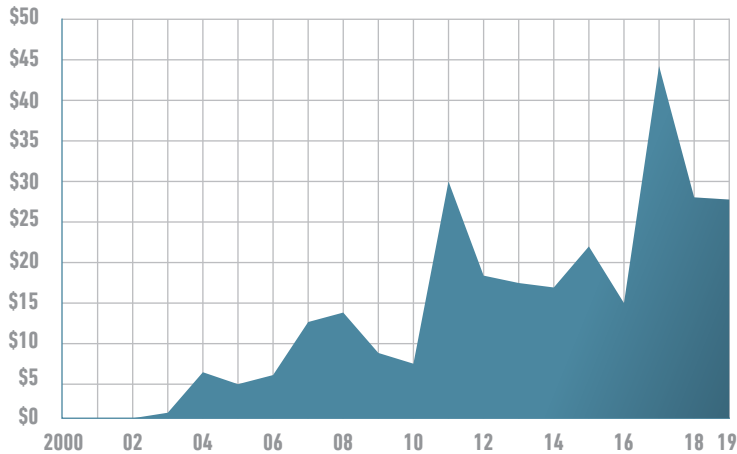
2019 ASSETS BY PARISH*

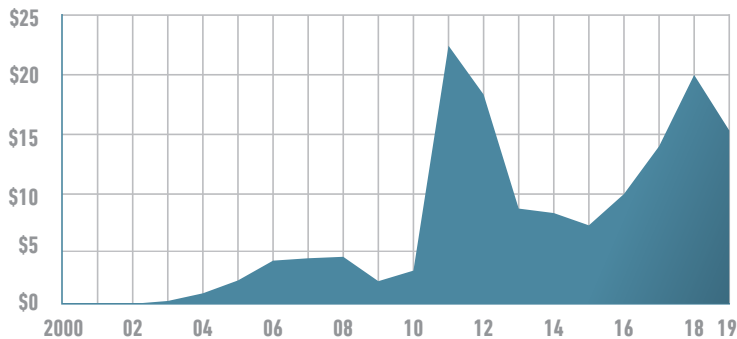
TOTAL GIFTS RECEIVED (in Millions)



SOUTH LOUISIANA GIVING DAY

South Louisiana (SOLA) Giving Day, an event of CFA, is a 24-hour online fundraising tool for nonprofit organizations, churches, and schools. Over the past two years, more than 130 organizations raised more than \$2.4M from 3,854 donors from 34 states and two other countries. Generous donors gave more than \$1.2M in matching contributions to help organizations double their donations. Many organizations fully funded a capital campaign, a special project, or purchased new equipment thanks to the donations received through the event. GRANTS AND PROGRAM EXPENSES (in Millions)



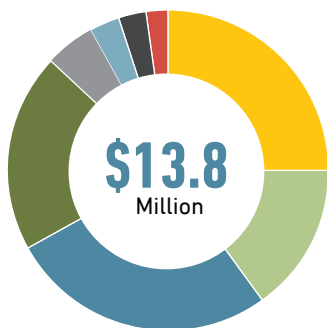

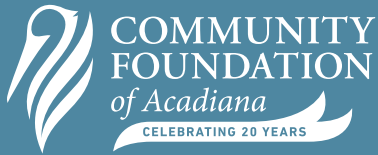

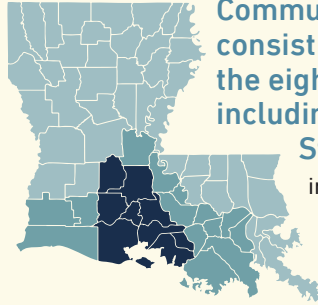
