

Joe and Gina Sanford are the recipients of the 2021 Leaders In Philanthropy Award for St. Mary Parish.

Joe and Gina were both born, raised, and continue to be lifelong residents of St. Mary Parish and have been married since 1993. Joe is the retired business owner of Morgan City Rentals and Gina is a retired teacher.

Gina attended Nicholls State University for 2 years and graduated from Samford University in 1991, playing tennis for both universities and ultimately winning conference at Samford her senior year.

Joe graduated from LSU in 1991 with a BA in Political Science. Joe has served as a board member for numerous organizations as well as President of the local boards for the St. Mary Industrial Group and American Petroleum Institute. Joe was a founding board member of the St. Mary Foundation, an Affiliate of Community Foundation of Acadiana. He also spent numerous years giving back to his community as a coach for the Dixie Youth.

The Sanfords basis of giving goes back to both of their families teaching the Christian values of giving back to the community and those less fortunate. Joe said it was his father who inspired him to give back, he was a generous man and Joe wanted to follow in his path. Before and especially after the sale of his company, Joe has continued to make generosity a top priority.
