- Open to everyone of all ages
- Pumpkins must be decorated or carved prior to the Fall Fest
- NO SCARY pumpkins are allowed
- You may use any paint or decor necessary to decorate your pumpkin

- Names of contestants **MUST** be listed on the **BOTTOM** of the pumpkin
- Pumpkins can be dropped off on Sunday 10/30 in Classroom 4 or on 10/31 no later than 5:45pm
- You **MUST** take your pumpkin home after Fall Fest
- Winners will be determined from the most votes and announced during Fall Fest at approximately 7:30pm





TRUNK-OR-TREAT RULES & REGS

- Bible themed trunks are encouraged but not required
- You must sign-up by Sunday, 10/30
- Candy will be supplied
- You may supply items other than candy
- NO SCARY trunks are allowed
- Trunks must be set-up and ready to go by 5:50pm (you may leave your vehicle overnight at the church after confirming with Von)





CHILI COOK-OFF RULES & REGS

- CHILI CAN'T BE STORE/RESTAURANT BOUGHT
- MUST BE COOKED BEFOREHAND AND AT THE CHURCH BY 5:30PM ON 10/31 - CROCKPOT SIZE
- EACH CHILI WILL BE ASSIGNED A # TO PROTECT THE CHEF'S IDENTITY AND ELIMINATE ANY PARTIALITY

CHILI WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- A. SIGHT: THE CHILI SHOULD LOOK APPETIZING
- B. AROMA: THE CHILI SHOULD SMELL GOOD
- C. CONSISTENCY: THE CHILI MUST HAVE A GOOD RATIO BETWEEN SAUCE AND MEAT (IT SHOULD NOT BE DRY, WATERY, GRAINY, LUMPY, OR GREASY)
- D. TASTE: TASTE, ABOVE ALL ELSE IS THE MOST IMPORTANT FACTOR (THE TASTE SHOULD CONSIST OF THE COMBINATION OF THE MEAT, SPICES, ETC. WITH NO PARTICULAR INGREDIENT BEING TOO DOMINANT)
